





1993 COBRA STYLE GRILLE INSERT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions

- 1. Trim provided template (pg. 2).
- 2. Tape the template to the passenger side of the bumper cover.
- 3. Trace area to be cut out of bumper cover with a marker.
- 4. Remove template and tape to the driver side of the bumper cover.
- 5. **CAREFULLY** cut the bumper cover along the lines thast were traced from the template. Make small cuts and trim as needed.
- 6. On the insert, there is a small stud located on the driver side. You must drill out a hole in your bumper cover or shave it off to compensate.
- 7. Scuff, prime, and paint insert.
- 8. Take note where the threaded stud is mounted on the Cobra grille. Mark the spot where the threaded stud touches the bumper cover and grill a 1/4 inch hole.
- 9. Install provided tape on back of grille insert where it contacts the front bumper cover.



- 10. Clean area where the Cobra grille insert meets the bumper cover with alcohol.
- 11. **CAREFULLY** position and apply Cobra grille insert to bumper cover. Apple gentle pressure with your hand to smooth insert and evenly apply tape.
- 12. Install the stud of the pony logo through the insert and into the bumper cover.
- 13. Install and tighten nut for pony on the backside of the bumper cover. Do **NOT** overtighten!
