Installation Instructions:

Support the transmission at stock height using an engine jack or floor jack (Pic 1). Once the position of the transmission is secure, remove the four bolts which secure the crossmember to the body and the two bolts that secure the crossmember to the transmission mount (Pic 2). Press the Transmission Insert (01P01335) from the front of the vehicle towards the rear into the three voids of the O.E. transmission mount (Pic 3). With the Transmission Insert installed completely against the mount, press the Insert Retainer (01P01338) into the holes of the Transmission Insert (01P01335) from the rear of the vehicle towards the front (Pic 4). Once both the insert and retainer are in place, reinstall the cross member and secure the transmission mount (Pic 5). Tighten the bolts to the factory recommended torque.
