
REMOVAL

 Remove the trim piece to the right of the glove box by carefully pulling it away from the dash. Remove the upper trim piece with the vents by carefully pulling it away from the dash. Remove the complete assembly from the vehicle.





2. Locate the four (4) locking tabs which retain the inner vent assembly to the cluster bezel. Select the vent to be replaced with the vent pod for the gauge location, and carefully depress all four (4) tabs to release the inner vent assembly.





NOTE: At this point, the inner vent assembly should be separated from the cluster bezel as shown below.





 Mark one of the locking tabs with a pencil or crayon. Locate the four (4) locking tabs which retain the decorative trim ring to the inner vent assembly. Carefully pry back on all four (4) tabs to release the trim ring.





4. Once the trim ring has been removed, carefully cut out the honeycomb center section off of the rear of the vent. Using a suitable cutting tool, clean any burrs or high spots. The amount of material removed will depend on the gauge (not included) that is being installed in the vent body.



INSTALLATION

1. Install the gauge of choice (not included) into the vent pod. Slide the gauge until it bottoms outs on the bezel surface.







 Reassemble the new gauge and vent pod assembly into the vent. Reinstall the trim ring aligning the mark made in Step 3 of Removal until each of the four (4) locking tabs have locked into position.







 Locate and align the inner vent housing assembly with the cluster bezel. Reinstall the inner vent housing until each of the four (4) locking tabs have locked into position. The trim ring should be seated flush with the cluster bezel and locked securely into position.



4. Before reinstalling the instrument cluster bezel, run all necessary wiring and hoses based on the gauge selection. A hole will need to be drilled in the duct work, in order to feed the wires into the back of the vent pod. The picture shown illustrates the hole for a vacuum hose and the necessary wiring.





5. Carefully reinstall the trim panel until all retaining tabs have been fully seated and the bezel is securely seated and flush with the dash surround. Ensure that all hoses and/or wiring have been connected to the gauge. Re-install the trim panel to the right of the glove box.
