



Auto Tech Trim Re-Nu Application Instructions

1. **FOR EXTERIOR USE:** Apply to clean, cool, dry surface – never in direct sunlight or to a hot surface.
2. **SHAKE WELL** before and during use. Apply to a clean cloth.
3. **IMPORTANT:** Rub cloth into surface with a back-and-forth motion (not circular). Rub area until cloth becomes dry (until any caked-on substance is removed) and until color is renewed. Then, turn cloth to clean section and repeat procedure on next area.
4. Allow to dry (buffing with a soft, dry cloth with improve some textured surfaces). Usually, one application is all that is needed to deep clean and restore color. Some especially dirty, faded surfaces may require a repeat application.
5. **NOTE: Trim RE-NU** is aided by the ultra-violet rays of the sun. For maximum results, **AFTER APPLYING**, place vehicle in direct contact with the sun. **DO NOT OPERATE VEHICLE IN RAIN UNTIL TREATED SURFACE IS COMPLETELY DRY.** To maintain renewed color, re-apply Trim RE-NU periodically.
6. For vinyl tops, slightly moisten cloth with water before applying – then buff top with a soft, dry cloth.
7. **Trim RE-NU** will not harm auto paint finish and easily wipes off finish with a soft, dry cloth.
