



Mustang Bumper Cover Paint Prep

Due to the manufacturing process on urethane and fiberglass body parts, it is common to see irregular surface patterns, buffing, and mold release marks. These marks are normal and will not be present once the product has been sanded, prepped, and painted to match your vehicle.

LMR recommends that this bumper cover be prepped, painted, and installed by qualified professionals.

Due to the variety of paint manufacturers and the different paint systems currently used by paint and body professionals, you must reference and follow the material manufacturer's recommended preparation instructions intended for the specific prep/paint products that will be used to finish this bumper cover.

All urethane bumpers must undergo the following steps to ensure a quality finish:

- Allow the bumper to go through at least one full heat cycle (paint booth or direct sunlight)
- Thorough cleaning: wipe the bumper with a solvent-based wax and grease remover to remove oils, grease, and contaminants
- Apply a light mechanical scuff using a mild liquid detergent (dish soap and grey scuff pad) be sure to cover all areas including tight corners and creases
- · Thorough cleaning of all areas of the bumper (including the back side) with an alcohol-based anti-static cleaner
- Adhesion promoter must be applied to the surface before paint process begins
- Paint sealer must be applied before base coat is applied
- The use of a flexible agent additive is HIGHLY recommended when applying any form of top coat to the bumper

Note: This bumper is covered by a 1 year limited warranty against defects in materials and workmanship. This warranty covers the bumper itself and does not include any paint or prep work.

Cost of removal, installation, and incidental or consequential damage are expressly excluded.
