

2015-23 Mustang PP1 Style Rear Spoiler Assembly Guide



(A) (4) Spoiler Mounting Nuts



(B) (4) Small Head Assembly Screws



(C) (6) Large Head Assembly Screws



** A #3 Phillips screwdriver is required for assembly of this PP1 style rear spoiler.*

** To ease installation, a small piece of masking tape can be used to hold the screws onto the driver during placement.*

- 1.) Unbox all components and arrange them on a clean, flat level surface, utilizing the provided protective foam to prevent damage to painted surfaces. Carefully inspect and verify that all components and hardware are present prior to beginning installation.
- 2.) Before beginning, carefully remove all protective film from the components. Starting with the main spoiler deck, position it upside down in the forward orientation. (See Figure 1.1)
- 3.) Position the center support onto the underside of the spoiler deck, aligning the mounting holes. Using the (4) supplied small head screws (B), securely fasten the center support to the spoiler. (See Figure 1.2) **Note:** loosely install all screws before tightening all the way down, this will ease the installation process.

4.) Position the side mounting brackets onto the spoiler. Using (3) large-head screws (C) per side, attach the side spoiler mounting brackets to the spoiler and tighten securely into place. Repeat this process for both sides. (See Figure 1.3)

5.) Once the side mounting brackets are securely installed, clip the hardware cover plate into the spoiler until it is fully seated and secured in place. (See Figure 1.4)

Before installing the spoiler onto the vehicle, apply the provided spoiler pads to the underside of the spoiler. These pads help protect the decklid surface and reduce vibration-related noise once the spoiler is installed. Ensure the pads are properly positioned and securely adhered before proceeding.

6.) Once the spoiler is fully assembled, position it onto the vehicle and secure it using the supplied (4) nuts (A). Verify that the spoiler is properly aligned, then tighten the nuts evenly until the spoiler is securely mounted in place.

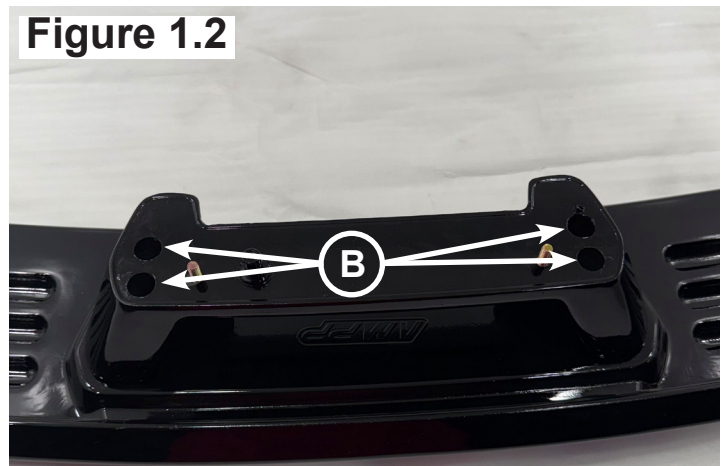
