

MUSTANG GEEK **1982-2001** **Door Hinge Roller Repair Kit**



No more annoying, floppy doors! If the door on your Mustang doesn't hold itself open anymore, the plastic hinge roller is worn out. Until now, the only way to replace the roller on 1982-1993 Mustangs was to press it out and replace the pin and roller...and on 1994-2001 Mustangs you have to replace the whole hinge! Like Grandma says: "F that!" Mustang Geek has a better idea: The Mustang Geek Door Hinge Roller replaces the worn-out plastic roller with a precision-machined billet roller that keeps the door open without having to pound anything out or replace the whole hinge. It's an easier solution to your floppy door woes! Only from Mustang Geek!

- Saves time and effort over replacing the pin and roller on 1982-1993 Mustangs
- Easier than replacing the whole hinge on 1994-2001 Mustangs!

- Kit includes one roller; two kits are required to service both doors.

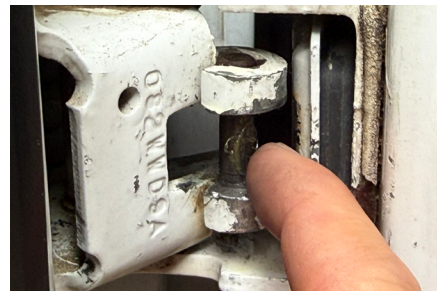
Step 1

Prop the door fully open and jam the roller with a screwdriver. Cut the roller in half using a rotary tool or drill with a 1/8" bit. Rotate the roller 180-degrees and repeat.



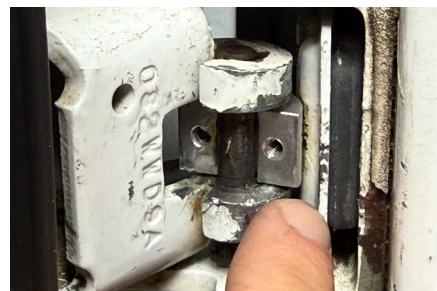
Step 2

Apply high-pressure grease to the axle.



Step 3

Hold the door fully open, then position one roller half with the threaded hole on the right. Release the door's weight to hold the roller in place.



Step 4

Apply blue thread locking compound to each of the #6-32 screws and loosely install the first screw.



Step 5

Rotate the roller to install the second screw. Tighten BOTH screws securely. Lubricate periodically with spray grease.
