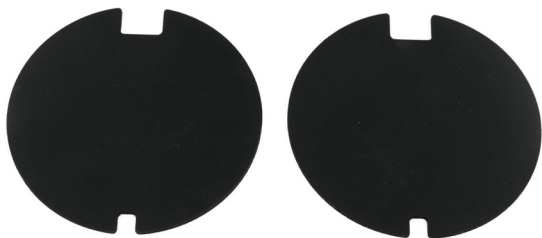

Side Mirror Vibration Gasket



If the side mirror glass on your 1994-2004 Mustang giggles and vibrates while driving, here's the fix! The Mustang Geek Side Mirror Vibration Gasket restores your side mirror's vibration isolation so it stops vibrating! The OEM foam "gasket" behind the side mirror glass shrinks and breaks down over time, leaving the mirror loose and allowing it to wiggle. The Mustang Geek Side Mirror Vibration Gasket is precision-cut from neoprene rubber so it damps vibrations and lasts longer than the factory foam isolator. Another problem-solver from Mustang Geek!

- Fits 1994-2004 Mustangs
- Solves annoying side mirror glass vibration issues
- Includes two gaskets (one for each side mirror)
- CNC-cut from neoprene rubber
- Installs in minutes

Step 1

Move the mirror so you can access the back side of the mirror.



Step 2

Using a 90-degree pic (or other suitable tool), carefully release the tabs holding the mirror to the power mirror mechanism.



Step 3

Remove the old mirror gasket and replace it with the Mustang Geek gasket.



Step 4

Apply a small amount of grease to the inside of the mounting tabs to ease reinstallation.



Step 5

Align the mirror on the mechanism and push firmly. Listen for a few "clicks." Using firm twisting motion helps the mirror fully seat on the mechanism.
