

## SVE-0514TOW Tow Hook Disclaimer



WARNING: This SVE tow hook is designed to provide a secure point to mount onto the vehicle for a slow speed and short duration in a controlled method of removal from off-track situations. Jerking a vehicle from this towing point is not advised and could result in damage. Proper Pulling with the SVE Tow Hook: Hook or tie to the tow hook with one end of a tow-rated chain or strap at least 25ft long. Position the end of the strap or chain out as far as it will go to take up any slack. The strap must be positioned within 45 degrees of the centerline of the vehicle to prevent damage to the bracket or the vehicle's frame. Hook or tie the other end to the tow vehicle in a place that is safe and correct. The driver of the stranded vehicle must be in the driver's seat during towing to control the steering wheel and brakes. Release the parking brake and put the transmission in neutral on the towed vehicle. The tow vehicle must slowly pull away from the towed vehicle until the strap is taught. Then again, slowly pull the vehicle to a roll, while the driver of the towed vehicle steers and brakes as needed to keep the strap or chain taught. Only tow until the towed vehicle is in a safe area to park or drive away. DO NOT TOW ANY VEHICLE FOR LONG PERIODS OF TIME!

<u>Utilizing the Tow Hook to Winch on a Trailer:</u> Normal use of the tow hook with a metal hook will result in possible hook damage. It is recommended to use a hook protector strap between the tow hook and a metal hook. This ensures no metal-to-metal contact or unevenly distributed loads on the hook or its finish.
