
WARNING: Never get underneath a vehicle that is supported only by a jack. The jack could unintentionally lower. Always support vehicle with floor stands. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious personal injury.

## **Front Jack Pad Installation**

- 1. Safely support the driver-side front corner from the pinch weld at the factory lift point (see diagram on next page)
- 2. Locate the (2) factory K-member to body 18mm retaining bolts (see *image*). We recommend the frontward location. Loosen and remove the 18mm bolts.
- 3. Apply blue thread locking compound to factory bolt and slide it through the front jack pad.
- 4. Position the front jack pad into place with the word "jack" and orientation line facing towards the outside of the car.
- 5. Run down the bolt and tighten to 85 lb-ft.
- 6. Lower the vehicle and repeat steps 1–5 for the passenger side.


## **Rear Jack Pad Installation**

- 1. Safely support the driver-side rear corner from the pinch weld approximately four inches in front of the factory lift point (see diagram on next page)
- 2. Locate the rearward most bolt hole grouping. The frontward hole in this grouping will be used (see image).
- 3. Slide one of the provided bolts through the rear jack pad.
- Position the rear jack pad into place with the word "jack" and the orientation line facing towards the outside of the car.
- 5. Run down the bolt and torque to 38-40 lb-ft.
- 6. Lower the vehicle and repeat steps 1–5 for the passenger side.
